CATEGORIES

Trophy will be celebrated in Absolute category.

PARTICIPATION

Open to all Clubs or National Teams which are members of Swimming European League (LEN) or Amateur Swimming International Federation (FINA).

All Clubs or National Teams interested in participating would have to report to the organization's email (openvillamairena@hotmail.com) their participation forecast before May 5th, 2025 indicating approximately the number of swimmers who will participate.

Will be able to participate swimmers with operative Federative License during the actual season, who accredit marks from July 1st, 2024.

Will be received the next number of participants per event, following the inscription ranking of best marks accredited. In case of the INCLUSIVE modality, will be admitted the best 16 Multi-Disability punctuations, following inscription marks.

Each swimmer (conventional or adapted) will be able to participate in a maximum of four individual events (FINA CHALLENGE not included) and in all relay events.

The organizing Club may register swimmers exceeding the number of participants established.

INSCRIPTIONS AND DOCUMENTATION

The inscriptions must be in the possession of the Andalusian Swimming Federation, specifically in the Sevillian Swimming Delegation, at the latest at 12:00 p.m. on Thursday, May 8th, 2025 (email: sevilla@fan.es).

The participating clubs will confirm by telephone the reception and acceptance of their registrations in the Andalusian Swimming Federation (Telf.: +34 696720423 Sevillian Swimming Delegation).

The inscriptions of Spanish teams will be made through the LEVERADE Platform of licenses of the Royal Spanish Swimming Federation.

Likewise, in case of claim, a photocopy of their identity will be attached to each participant: DNI, Passport or Federal License.

Those who participate in adapted events, will have to add a Territorial License certificate (FADDF, FADC, FANDDI, FADPC) to their inscription, with the next information:

- A mark and its multidisability points.
- Funcional class.
- Exceptions, if there were.

The absence of any of this information doesn't allow to make a full registration.

On Monday, May 12th, 2025, the provisional list of registrants will be published. From this day on, only bug fixes will be accepted.





EDICIÓN ESPECIAL "JUANMA FERNÁNDEZ SANTANA" -

For each registration in the individual event, a fee of €7.00 must be paid and for each relay event €10.00, the payment must be made no later than Thursday, May 15th, 2025 at 12:00 p.m.

On Friday, May 16th, 2025, the definitive list of admitted participants will be published, after which no modifications will be accepted.

CANCELLATIONS AND MODIFICATIONS

Withdrawals must be communicated not later than 30 minutes before the start of the competition.

COMPETITION SYSTEM

The series will be made following the times accredited in the registration sheets.

The competition will be held with an electronic scoreboard.

The competition system will be by elimination rounds and finals. The 1,500 and 800 meter tests will be swum by a time trial system, swimming the 8 best accredited times on the corresponding morning according to the test program.

The qualifying sessions (mornings) will be organized so that the last three series of each test, at distances of 50, 100 and 200 meters, and the last two at distances of 400 meters, are swum at the beginning of the session, with the rest of series of each test being disputed once this program is finished.

In the 50 and 100 meters tests, FINAL "A" and "B" will be swum. In the distances of 200 and 400 meters, only one FINAL "A" will be swum. 2 athletes will be established as reserves in each of the events to cover any possible absence for the finals. Absences for the finals must be communicated to the Competition Management within 15 minutes after the corresponding elimination session ends. Swimmers will be considered as NOT PRESENT for penalty purposes if they do not communicate their absence in a timely manner.

Excusively the 100 meters test will be part of the INCLUSIVE Swimming Program. The elimination rounds of this modality, will be swum by all inscribed (conventional+adapted). Acces to the finals will be determined by the points obtained in the elimination rounds, following Multi-Disability table. There will be a Adapted Swimming final. If in any event of the adapted category there are not at least 6 registered participants, it will be contested as a direct final in the corresponding final session.







In the 1,500 and 800 meter tests, swimmers will have to choose one of the two distances, that is, the same swimmer will not be able to compete in the 1,500 meter test and the 800 meter test, they will have to choose to participate in one of the two. For this, he may enroll in both distances, if he deems it appropriate, and once the provisional list is published, if he has been admitted to both distances, he will have to give up one of them.

PENALTIES

Penalty of 5 € for each WITHDRAWAL

Penalty of €35 for each NO SHOW

Penalty of €50 for IMPROPER PARTICIPATION.

This penalties will be charged from the moment that the provisional list of registrants be published.

PUNCTUATION

The top sixteen finishers in each test will score.

The score to follow will be as follows: 1st (19p), 2nd (16p), 3rd (14p), 4th (13p), 5th (12p)... 16th (1p).

The RELAY tests will have double points following the reference applied in the individual categories.

CLASIFICATIONS

Combined Final by Clubs (sum of all points in men's and women's events).

A general act of the trophy will be issued detailing all the participants.

Team relay events must be made up of two male swimmers and two female swimmers from each club. These tests will score for the classification by clubs.

The "Three Cultures" relay events are left out of the general classification of clubs. These special tests are a hallmark of the Trophy.

The "Three Cultures" relay of 4 x 100 meters freestyle and mixed styles, will be formed with the participation of two male and two female swimmers.

The mixed 4x100 freestyle teams will be formed by the organization taking into account the 16 best male swimmers and the 16 best female swimmers of the 100 meter freestyle event, following the criteria set by the organization.

The 4x100 mixed styles teams will be formed by the organization among the 4 best male swimmers and female swimmers classified in the different 100-meter tests of each style, following the criteria set by the organization.

All swimmers registered in the 100-meter events will be considered eligible to compete in the "Three Cultures" relays unless they formally withdraw. The withdrawal must be made through the Competition Management before the end of the last eligible event for the relay in question. If an athlete does not show up for the relay and has not formally withdrawn in a timely manner, they will be considered as NOT PRESENT for penalty purposes.







"FINA CHALLENGE" EVENTS

FINA CHALLENGE is an **original event** of this XXVII Trofeo Villa de Mairena del Aljarafe's edition where the **LEVEL of the MARK will be the one that will determine the champion** of the challenge, above the style or if it's male or female, so this events will be mixed. This event won't punctuate for the clubs clasification.

There will be two modalities, FINA CHALLENGE 100 and FINA CHALLENGE 200.

- **FINA CHALLENGE 100:** It will be a 100-meter final where will participate the 4 best FINA inscription marks in male category, and the 4 best in female category. Each swimmer will compete in the style in which is classified.
- FINA CHALLENGE 200: It will be a 200-meter final where will participate the 4 best FINA inscription marks in male category, and the 4 best in female category. Each swimmer will compete in the style in which is classified.

Final Ranking of each event will be determined by the FINA points earned by each competitor in the final, male or female category.

All the swimmers inscribed in 100 and 200 meter events will be selectable for the FINA CHALLENGE, unless they formally quit by email (sevilla@fan.es) before the definitive list publication.

TROPHIES AND AWARDS

- A) TEAMS- Trophies will be awarded to the first three Clubs resulting from the joint classification.
- **B) INDIVIDUALS** Medals will be awarded to the top three finishers in each event, conventional and adapted.

The cash prizes will be distributed according to the score of the current FINA table (male+female) as follows:

- 1. To access this men's and women's classification, each swimmer has to participate in three individual events of the official program of the competition. Will count the best FINA punctuation of all the test in that will have participated.
- 2. Each swimmer will only be able to access the prize corresponding to the best position obtained in this classification, eliminating from it the remaining positions that could be obtained.
- 3. The collection of the prize for the swimmers classified for the final is conditional on their participation in it and only the FINA points obtained in it will be taken into consideration.

There will be a 200€ prize for the adapted swimmer (male or female) with the best multidisability punctuation, and 40€ for his/her coach, in the event with the higher punctuation.

"27th EDITION" SPECIAL PRIZE A special prize of 600,00€* will be awarded to the swimmer (male or female) who scores more FINA points adding up all the test that swim in the Trophy, maximum 4 marks. Will be valid marks made in individual tests, both in elimination rounds and finals, and in the FINA CHALLENGE too.







"FINA CHALLENGE" PRIZE: Prizes will be awarded to the top three swimmers (male or female) on each challenge's events (FINA CHALLENGE 100 and/or FINA CHALLENGE 200).
